What are integration guides?

Integration guides are citizens of different ages and different origins who volunteer their services. They are prepared for their duties with qualification seminars.

In addition to German, other languages spoken include English, Albanian, French, Italian, Arabic, Kazakh, Afrikaans, Bantu, Khoisan, Turkish, Polish, Russian, Georgian and Lebanese.

What do integration guides do?

Integration guides accompany people to consultation services, authorities, schools, childcare centres, physicians, associations etc. and support people with an immigration background with the matters which concern them.

They provide information about offers and opportunities in the city, for example schools, family centres as well as culture, educational, sports and leisure offerings.

Who can use integration guides?

Integration guides can be used at no charge by people with an immigration background.

Integration guides can be asked about offices and authorities, educational institutions and intercultural institutions.

All queries and personal information are of course treated confidentially.
